In 2018, we introduced the warmer Stadium School jackets to our uniform. These jackets have been very popular and offer an option of a warmer winter appropriate jacket for the cooler months.

We held 9 lunch order days. This year with the help of our very dedicated lunch order day team we were able to offer a variety of lunches, from pizzas, pie, hotdog, sausage sizzle to donuts. SCHOOL OPERATING TIMES FROM 2019

Commencing from day one, term one 2019, our school operating hours will change.

In 2019, Armidale High School will cease to exist, as students will be at the Duval High School site attending Armidale Secondary College. Therefore, buses will not be required to visit the current Armidale High School location. As a result many bus runs will change as the buses will need to move larger numbers of students to the current Duval site.

Many schools in Armidale will need to adjust their starting and finishing times to accommodate the required changes.

Martin's Gully Public School will start at 9am and finish at 3pm from Day 1, 30 January, 2019.

This will result in a teacher being on playground duty from 8.30am each morning.

Many of the bus runs will commence at Martin's Gully Public School, therefore causing some bus times to change also. Edwards Bus Company has consulted with all schools in Armidale throughout the year and will begin to confirm changes to timetables with families as we move closer to the start of 2019.

In 2019 our school will operate along the following times:	
8.30am-9.00am	Morning Playground Duty
9.00am-11.05am	1 st Session
11.05am-11.30am	Recess Break
11.30am-1.00pm	Middle Session
1.00pm-1.50pm	Lunch Break
1.50pm-3.00pm	Afternoon Session
3.00pm	End of the school day

Students who catch a bus to and from school will receive information from Edwards Coaches mid January to advise of new times. If you would like to contact the bus company, please call them on 6772 3116.
